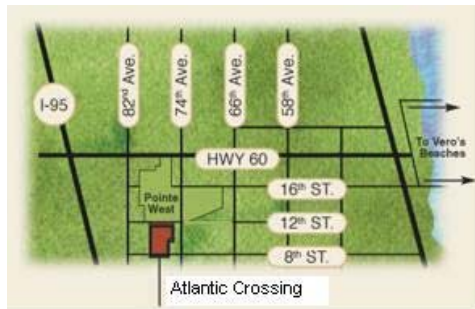
CLOSING DATES FOR PRE-REGISTRATION – Monday Prior to Each Show

We will be starting Dressage Group Classes at 9:00 am, Hunters and Dressage Tests at 9:30 am unless entries dictate an earlier start time. Divisions may be combined and/or split depending on entries. Day stabling available again this year – please register early to guarantee availability.

Individual Dressage Tests	\$20/class.
Group Classes	\$15/class
Hunter Classes	\$15 individually, or \$35/division if PRE-REGISTERED BY CLOSING DATE. \$20 ea. if registering at show (adds by pre-registered competitors @ the reduced rate.)
Day Stabling (VERY limited # available)-if with a group please note on entry	\$35 - Must be pre-registered with Coggins Test on file prior to arrival. <i>Light initial bedding provided; add'l shavings will be available for purchase.</i>

DRESSAGE PRIZE LIST

- G1. Suitability to Be a Dressage Horse** – judged on horse’s potential for dressage work. To walk, trot and canter both directions. Open to any horse/rider combination.
- G2. Dressage Basics for Young Horses** – judged on potential and basics of training. Open to any horse/pony under the age of 7.
- G3. Dressage Equitation for Junior Riders** – judged on correctness of rider’s seat and correct use of the aids for dressage. Open to any junior rider (under 18). May be combined with G4 if less than 5 entries.
- G4. Dressage Equitation for Adults** – judged on correctness of rider’s seat and correct use of the aids for dressage. Open to any adult rider (18 and over). May be combined with G3 if less than 5 entries.
- G5. Walk-Trot Dressage Basics for Juniors** – judged both on rider’s seat and aids, and correct basics of horse/pony. Riders will walk and trot only (no canter) Open to any junior rider. May be combined with G6 if less than 5 entries.
- G6. Walk-Trot Dressage Basics for Adults** - judged both on rider’s seat and aids, and correct basics of horse/pony. Riders will walk and trot only (no canter) Open to any adult rider. May be combined with G5 if less than 5 entries.

For Test of Choice classes, please state which test you are riding. Classes will be pinned/split between JR/YR, AA, and Open if entries warrant.

***Class T12 is for entry the day of the show. If you would like to add an additional test, because your horse thought the dressage judge was going to eat him, a palm tree looked at him funny, or the very cute small child on the pony was really a goblin (or maybe you just got show nerves 😊) you can enter this class to get a second chance to ride your test! See the show secretary – entries will be accepted up until the first rider in this class enters at A! ***

HUNTER PRIZE LIST

DIVISION D1

H1 & H2 – Kids (12 and under) Walk-Trot Hunter – Jump a Crossrail

H3 – Kids (12 and under) Walk-Trot Hunter – U/S

Open to any child age 12 or younger

DIVISION D2

H4 & H5 – Junior/Adult Walk-Trot Canter – Jump a Crossrail

H6 – Junior/Adult Walk-Trot Canter – Under Saddle

Open to any junior 13-18 or any adult horse/rider combination in their first year of showing over fences together. Cannot cross enter any other over fences classes.

DIVISION D3

H7 & H8 – Short Stirrup Hunter – 2’

H9 – Short Stirrup Hunter U/S

Open to any child twelve or younger

DIVISION D4

H10 & H11 – Long Stirrup Hunter – 2’

H12 – Long Stirrup Hunter U/S

Open to any junior 13-18 and adult riders

DIVISION D5

H13 & H14 – Low/Schooling Hunter – 2’3

H15 – Low/Schooling Hunter U/S

Open to any horse/rider combination

DIVISION D6

H16 & H17 – Baby Green Hunter – 2’3

H18 – Baby Green Hunter U/S

Open to horses that are in their first or second year of showing over fences

DIVISION D7

H19 & H20 – Junior/Adult Equitation 2’3

H21 – Junior/Adult Equitation U/S

Open to any horse/rider combination-May be split into Jr/Sr if entries warrant

DIVISION D8

H22 & H23 – Low Hunter 2’6

H24 – Low Hunter U/S

Open to any horse/rider combination

H25 – Hunter Hack 2’ (to walk, trot and canter and jump two 2’ fences)

H26 – Hunter Hack 2’3 (to walk, trot and canter and jump two 2’3 fences)

H27 – Hunter Hack 2’6 (to walk, trot and canter and jump two 2’3 fences)

JUMPER SECTION

H28 – Beginning Jumpers 2’

H29 – Schooling Jumpers 2’3

H30 – Hopeful Jumpers 2’6

H31 – Training Jumpers 2’9

H32 – Leadline Class – Ages 8 and Under (to be lead on horse/pony)
